

Design Offer: pursuing Step 3, 4 or 5

- (1) Integrated Design Process: \$1,000 rebate, must use pre-approved IDP facilitator
- (2) Envelope Design and (3) Mechanical Design: up to \$6,000 in rebates, must use a building science consultant and/or mechanical design specialist








BC Energy Step Code 3

Example: Town House Development




